ARTICLE 1.

The Transport Office undertakes the transport of the objects in accordance with its regulations, in combination with its price list and only for destinations where there are routes.

ARTICLE 2.

The Office of Transport unaccompanied transport receipt is a negotiable document. The sender accepts that the document was completed by the competent employee of the Office with instructions and on his behalf. The sender also declares that he is the main legal owner, legal owner or authorized by them of the objects entrusted for transport, as well as that he accepts the terms of the "Office" both for himself and for the agent, owner of the object.

ARTICLE 3.

the sender guarantees that: a) the item to be transported is properly packed, so that their safe transportation is ensured. b) the details of the sender and recipient are correctly and clearly filled out both on the item and on the delivery receipt.

ARTICLE 4.

The "Transportation Office" does not undertake to transport items containing any of the following prohibited materials, substances, etc.

a) explosive materials, b) compressed gases, c) flammable materials. d) corrosive substances, e) poisons, f) radioactive materials, g) drugs, n) money and monetary values (cash, cheques, shares, etc.), i) objects of great value (jewelry, etc.), j) items that by their nature or their packaging can cause damage to other items or luggage or to the means of transport or to the staff. The sender bears sole responsibility for any damages that may arise from the transportation of such items.

ARTICLE 5.

The "Transport Office" has the right, but not the obligation, to check and even open the object it receives for transport and if it finds that it contains prohibited substances, to contact the competent authorities (police, customs, etc.) and to refuse his transfer.

ARTICLE 6.

The "Transport Office" is under no obligation to notify the recipient, who should be informed by the sender and in the event that there is no agency or representative of the "Transport Office" at the destination, the recipient should wait for the arrival of the item himself, otherwise this will be returned to the nearest delivery agency or representative.

After 45 days the items are considered "lost" when they are not received and are in the possession of the Transport Office. The objects whose shipment could not be carried out and its contents are subject to rot or damage, has the right to destroy it without warning the beneficiary.

ARTICLE 7.

If the items or part of them are lost or damaged or their contents in whole or in part are lost, the sender is entitled to compensation, which in no case may exceed the limit below:

For loss of parcels or objects the amount of €50.00 (Fifty Euros)

The compensation up to the above amounts is calculated based on the value of the item as it appears on the invoice in the proof of purchase. However, in no case can the compensation paid by the "Office" exceed the upper limits.

ARTICLE 8.

The request for payment of compensation for an object that was lost due to damage to its contents in whole or in part, is submitted in writing to the secretariat of the "Transportation Office" within 10 calendar days from the date of its delivery for transport, together with the presentation of proof of unaccompanied transport, otherwise any relevant right is barred.

ARTICLE 9.

The "Transportation Office" bears no responsibility, nor is it obliged to any compensation in the following cases:

a) loss or damage caused by an error on the part of the sender or recipient (poor packaging, wrong declaration of destination, wrong entry of recipient details), b) loss or damage of objects whose transportation is prohibited according to article 4 of this contract, c) for lost profits and reserve life due to delay delivery of the item, d) for losses or damages due to force majeure and caused by events that cannot be foreseen or are beyond the control of the "Transport Office" (eg. traffic accident, theft, weather conditions, fire, etc.).

ARTICLE 10.

For any dispute arising between the sender and the "Transport Office", an effort is made in the first phase to resolve them through negotiations between the management of the "Transport Office" and the sender based on the rules of good will. If a dispute is not resolved, the competent court is the city of Thessaloniki, where the "Transport Office" is headquartered.
